Petition of Daniel L. McKeon

Pursuant to due notice the Board of Appeal held a public hearing in the hearing room on the second floor of the Town Hall at 8:10 p.m. on November 19, 1970, on the petition of Daniel L. McKeon, requesting that an amendment be made to the decision of the Board of Appeal, dated March 15, 1960, which would permit the coin-operated laundromat, located at 253 Washington Street, to remain open from midnight Saturday night until 6:00 a.m. Monday morning. Said petition was made under the provisions of Section XXIV-B of the Zoning By-law.

Henry D. White, Attorney, represented the petitioner at the hearing.

A petition favoring the request was submitted which was signed by approximately two hundred patrons.

Statement of Facts

The petitioner seeks permission to amend the decision of the Board of Appeal, recorded with the Town Clerk on March 15, 1960, which would allow the coin-operated laundromat to remain open on Sunday. It was pointed out at the hearing that the General Laws of the Commonwealth were amended in 1970 eliminating the time restrictions with respect to the operation of such self-service laundries, and it is the desire of the petitioner that the Board's decision conform with the General Laws.

Decision

Upon further consideration of the above-mentioned decision this Board hereby amends said decision as follows:

- (1) That condition #1 is hereby deleted in its entirety, and shall be replaced by the following condition:

"The Board reserves the right to make rules and regulations relative to the operation of said laundromat and to determine the hours that it may remain open at the location in question."
