Petition of John L. Worley

Pursuant to due notice the Board of Appeal held a public hearing in the hearing room on the second floor of the Town Hall at 8:00 p.m. on April 27, 1972, on the petition of John L. Worley for permission to continue to use the premises at 637 Washington Street as a rooming and lodging house as provided under Section XXIV-E of the Zoning By-law.

On February 29, 1972, the petitioner filed application for a hearing before this Board and thereafter due notice of the hearing was given by mailing and publication.

Statement of Facts

At the hearing the petitioner requested a renewal of the permit granted to him a year ago by this Board. He stated that his conditions have not changed during the past year and that he still needs the income he receives from the roomers to maintain the property. He has four roomers and uses only the first and second floors as restricted in the Board's decision. He further stated that it is his home and he does not care to have any more roomers than he now has. No complaints to his knowledge have been made during the past year relative to the use of the property.

Decision

The Board finds that the conditions in this case are substantially the same as they were a year ago when it granted a permit for the premises to be used as a rooming and lodging house for one year.

It is the opinion of the Board that because of the size of the house and the number of rooms which it contains, it can no longer be used or adapted at a reasonable expense and with a fair financial return for a use regularly permitted within a Single-residence District.

Accordingly, the requested permission is granted under the provisions of Section XXIV-E of the Zoning By-law for one year from the expiration of the permit for which this is a renewal and upon the conditions set forth in the Board's decision on, "Petition of John L. Worley" filed with the Town Clerk on February 9, 1959.
