The following subjects are under study by the Planning Board and will be discussed:

1. Changes to the Flood Plain Zoning Bylaw to meet the new Federal Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) and Federal Emergency Management Agencies (FEMA) criteria, county mapping system, and new Base Flood Elevations.
2. An amendment or amendments to modify and update the off street parking section of the Zoning Bylaw.

The Planning Board may bring other matters to this meeting for discussion and encourages any other issue which may involve a Zoning Bylaw or Zoning Map amendment to be brought up for discussion at this meeting.
