In accordance with M.G.L., Chapter 85, Section 3B, and Chapter 41, Section 81B, and the authority vested therein, the Planning Board will hold a public hearing at a meeting to begin at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, May 19, 2014 in the Great Hall in Town Hall, 525 Washington Street, to consider a request by Robert and Deborah Brown of 44 Lincoln Street to change the name of the portion of Lincoln Street located within the Town of Wellesley (an unaccepted way) to South Lincoln Street. In 2013 the Town of Natick changed the name of the portion of the street within Natick to South Lincoln Street. If approved, the entire street would be known as South Lincoln Street and all properties along the street would be similarly addressed.
