Your school is on-board with Green Cleaning!


The products and procedures being used in your school are the **greenest** and **cleanest** available, providing a clean and safe environment for all students and staff.

Keep the dirt out!


The best way to keep your school clean is to keep the dirt out in the first place.

- Handrails
- Restroom fixtures
- Locker rooms and showers
- Light switches
- And other critical common touch points.



What are green cleaning chemicals?

An easy way to identify a green cleaning chemical is to see if it is green certified.

- These products go through a stringent evaluation process
- They eliminate the use of toxic chemicals and indoor pollutants.
- Dispensing systems mix chemicals and water automatically, eliminating direct contact with chemical concentrates.
