

***Acer saccharum* – Sugar Maple**



Foliage: Green in summer, orange and yellow in fall

Habit: In youth often pyramidal becoming rounded

Bark: Smooth in youth, furrowed and ridged with age

Flowers: Greenish yellow in April before leaves emerge

Fruit: Green samara

Size: 50+ feet

Culture: Full sun

Landscape Value: Sugar Maples are one of the best native shade trees for form and color. Many improved cultivars available.
