

From cardboard to hazardous waste, about 14,000 tons of material passed through the Wellesley Recycling and Disposal Facility in 2014. Come for a behind-the-scenes look at the recyclables, reusables, and just plain trash that the RDF handles with care. At this two-hour workshop, you'll learn how the RDF managers find gold in our garbage--and you'll hear what lies ahead for Wellesley's 42-year-old facility. After the workshop, we'll take an optional tour of the RDF (weather permitting).

This public workshop is co-sponsored by the Wellesley Department of Public Works, the Natural Resources Commission, and the Sustainable Energy Committee. This workshop is the first step in a collaborative process to identify initiatives that will increase recycling in Wellesley and make our RDF even better.
