900 Worcester Street Update:

Mr. Harrington will be attending a School Committee meeting regarding the High School Stadium project and will inform the School Committee that the 900 Worcester Street project will be too far for HS sports activities, and the site would only be used for Recreation and youth sports.

Bathhouse Flooring:

Mrs. Kaseta informed the Commission that flooring work has started and is close to completion except for an area where water was found pooling. The leak was found and repaired, and is now drying. Once dry, the floor company will return to complete the work.

Advisory Meeting – October 24th:

Mr. Antonelli will work on an informational presentation for the meeting.

Mr. Harrington will construct a slide that will explain the two revolving accounts that Recreation departments may use.

Programming Registration to Date:

Mr. Chin informed the Commission that the Department is approximately \$5k behind where we were last year. However, there are about 100 more programs that haven't started yet this season.

Winter Ski Plans:

Mr. Kennedy informed the Commission that in addition to the Wednesday & Friday ski programs, and the cross country ski programs, he is working with Natick Recreation to organize a middle/high school day ski trip.

Staff Report:

Mrs. Kaseta asked Commissioners if any of them would be participating in the Trunk or Treat program. She also mentioned that the Department is considering canceling the program based on the low interest in registration.

The Senior Center planning committee is looking for a Commission member and staff member to join the committee.

Mr. Kennedy’s job classification and pay scale has been increased.
