**Morses Pond Facility Upgrade:**

**Quote for Floors:** Mrs. Kaseta informed the Commission that the Facilities &  
Maintenance Department is waiting on another quote, as the first bid came in too high.  
Mr. Conlin suggested that CPC funds might be able to be used for this.

**Ceiling Fans:** Mr. Neville of Facilities & Maintenance will be looking at the possibility  
of installing fans in the men's and women's rooms. He will also complete the installation  
of motion lights.

**Morses Pond Neighborhood Concerns:**

Mr. Harrington would like to have a hearing to allow the neighborhood to voice their  
concerns.

**Use of Recreation Surplus for Pool Study:**

Mr. Conlin would like to use \$50k of the Recreation surplus to help fund a pool study for the 900 Worcester Street Project. Mr. Wrobel feels that there should be consistency in the process where all three subcommittee should be given the same opportunity/treatment.

**Tennis Court Lights – Musco Project:**

Mrs. Kaseta informed the Commission that before moving forward with any changes, the Department would look at lowering the demand charge by changing the timing of when the multipurpose lights would be turned on.

**900 Worcester Street Committee:**

Mr. Wrobel informed the Commission that the subcommittees have been meeting and continuing their due diligence.
