Business:

Staff Report:

- Mrs. Kaseta informed the Commission that she brought in a security specialist to get a quote on adding two security cameras to the Warren Building. The interest in security cameras is due to the recent break in to the Recreation office and two occasions of someone breaking into the vending machines.
- Judd Thomas and Alex Searls (staff at Morses Pond) presented a quote for their plan to organize the parking lot at Morses Pond.

Motion: By Mr. Conlin to approve the purchase of timbers, rebar and paint, up to the cost of \$2,000, to upgrade and organize the parking lot at Morses Pond.

- Mr. Wrobel and the Commission have asked the Recreation Staff to obtain a quote on the extending the fishing pier.
- The Commission asked Mr. Kennedy to get a quote to install two monitor at the main doors.
- The Commission also asked the Recreation staff to put together a list of potential needs for the department.

Mr. Wrobel has repeatedly reached out to Joe Kahn in order to invite him to a Commission meeting, but he has not heard back from Joe.

General Discussion – Programs & Facilities:

Mr. Wrobel presented the Commission with the three design options for fixing the basketball courts located across the street from Wellesley High School.

Mr. Wrobel started the discussion on possible candidates to fill Ms. Baier’s seat. Mr. Wrobel spoke about Trip Sheehan’s involvement in town sports and his interest in becoming involved with the Playing Fields Task Force.

Citizen Speak:

Two Boy Scouts, Matthew & Jarrett Huddleston, were in attendance and they asked the Commission about potential Eagle Scout projects that could be done through Recreation. They will stay in touch with Mrs. Kasetta.
