

Board of Selectmen – April 14, 2010

Call to order: Meeting called to order at 6:45 pm in the Middle School Library.

Business:

The Board approved and signed the Warrant for the May 11, 2010 Special State Senate Election.

Board members heard a report from Ms. Tsagaris, Mr. Larsen, Mr. Ketchen and Mr. Robinson concerning negotiations earlier in the day with Charles C. and Charles A. Crevo. The Board agreed to seek support from Advisory for an appropriation of \$1.1 million to acquire 494 Washington Street (vs. a price of \$1.27 million as rejected by Town Meeting at the April 12, 2010 session of the Special Town Meeting). In light of this, the Board agreed to ask Mr. Himmelberger to not move for reconsideration, and to withdraw his motion for an appropriation of 1.0 million. In the event the motion at \$1.1 million failed, the Board agreed not to present a motion at any other dollar amount.

At 7:05, the meeting was adjourned and the Selectmen proceeded to the Advisory Committee Meeting prior to the resumption of the Special Town Meeting (being held within the Annual Town Meeting).
