The Wellesley Planning Board will hold a public hearing to review the adequacy of the frontage of #21 and #25 Kimlo Road in accordance with Section XIX, Yard Regulations, A., of the Zoning Bylaw, due to the proposed alteration in parcels lines between 21 and 25 Kimlo Road in order to create two building lots fronting on Kimlo Road. The applicant is Kimlo Trust, Paul Bevilacqua, Trustee. The intent of the meeting is to determine if improvements will be required to this unaccepted way in order to upgrade the way to a status of adequacy. This meeting is held in accordance with the requirements of Section XIX, Yard Regulations, A., of the Zoning Bylaw and the Rules and Regulations Governing Upgrading of Inadequate Ways.
