North 40 Public Workshops

The North 40 Steering Committee in consultation with Dodson & Flinker, Inc. and Brovitz Community Planning and Design, will be hosting a series of public workshops to create a Vision for the potential use of the North 40 for municipal purposes. The following workshops are scheduled:

Neighborhood Workshop for Weston Road and Woodlands Neighbors

Town-Wide Workshop – Two Sessions Available
Sunday, September 14th 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm
Sunday, September 14th 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm
Wellesley High School Cafeteria

The workshops will explore how residents currently use and value the North 40 and surrounding area, and will consider the varied relationships between the North 40 and the adjacent neighborhoods and Morses Pond. Participants will be encouraged to identify issues and opportunities for alternative land uses, and to develop goals for any potential municipal use located on the site. This visioning exercise will in no way determine the final use of the land should the Town acquire the site, but rather will inform the Board of Selectmen on whether the residents of Wellesley see value and potential opportunity to expand services and assets with acquisition of the site.
