

## LEGAL NOTICE

### **Wellesley Community Preservation Committee**

#### **Public Hearing**

The Wellesley Community Preservation Committee ("CPC") will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. in the community room of the Wellesley Police Station, 485 Washington Street for the purposes of soliciting comments on the request made to the CPC by the Board of Selectmen for use of CPA funds for a number of potential projects sponsored by Town boards and committees.

The CPC is seeking public comments on the following:

- A request from the Wellesley Historical Society for \$6,200 to support the processing and preservation of the Urann Archival Collection;
- A request from the Wellesley Historical Commission for \$95,000 to support the expansion of the historic building date plaque program;
- A request from the Wellesley Natural Resources Commission, in conjunction with the DPW, the Recreation Commission and the School Department, for \$2,500 to perform a land use and needs assessment of the Kelly Field Tennis Court;
- A request from the Wellesley Natural Resources Commission for \$20,000 to conduct a study of the erosion of the Morse Pond shoreline;
- A request from the Natural Resources Commission for \$100,000 to undertake a study to assess and prioritize immediate concerns at the Town's many ponds in order to develop a long-term restoration and maintenance program;
- A request from the Playing Fields Task Force for \$900,000 to assist in the rehabilitation of the track and playing field located on Rice Street, across from Wellesley High School.

The CPC also desires to solicit public comments at the hearing regarding the Town's overall community preservation needs, possibilities and resources.
