Business:

The Board voted to call a Special Election for Wednesday, May 18, 2011 for the purpose of placing a debt exclusion question on the ballot regarding the proposed Department of Public Works operations building.

The Board voted to approve the recommendation of the Wellesley Scholarship Foundation for the 2011-2012 Wellesley College Town Scholarships.

The Board approved a payment date of September 30th for a payment of \$40,000 pursuant to the Linden Square development agreement.

The Board voted to support the Planning Board's proposed amendment to the Tree Bylaw motion at Annual Town Meeting.

The Board voted to approve the contract agreement reached between the Town's negotiating team and the Department of Public Works Supervisory Unit.

The Board voted that the following language be placed on the ballot for the May 18, 2011 Special Election:

“Shall the Town of Wellesley be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition two and one-half, so called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to fund the plans and specifications, construction, remodeling, equipping and furnishing of a new Department of Public Works office facility at 20 Municipal Way?”

The Board voted to support updating the Massachusetts Bottle Bill.

At 7:14, the meeting was adjourned and the Selectmen proceeded to Annual Town Meeting.
