

To Town Meeting Members

As you know, at the April 6 session of Annual Town Meeting, the Moderator indicated that Article 15 would be held open until after the Special Town Meeting on Monday, April 12.

Article 15 relates to the stand-alone Senior Center. A motion will be brought under this article if the motion under Article 3 of the Special Town Meeting (land acquisition at 494 Washington Street) is passed. If it is not passed, no motion will be brought under Article 15.

A motion under Article 15 will seek an appropriation of \$57,500 for the design work associated with the acquisition of 494 Washington Street. Specifically, funds requested under this motion will be for site work related to the acquisition and the design of additional parking spaces to enhance the Senior Center site.

The supplementary funding that will be necessary to construct the parking spaces and related expenses on the 494 Washington Street parcel are estimated to be \$230,000. These costs will be included in the request for funding for the Senior Center at a Special Town Meeting in the fall.
