

REPORT OF THE WELLESLEY HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION

The Wellesley Historic District Commission consists of seven members appointed by the Board of Selectmen as specified in Article 18 of the Wellesley Town Bylaws. The Commission has the powers and duties of Historic District Commissions in accordance with the Historic Districts Acts, Chapter 40C of the Massachusetts General Laws.

Cases

During the period of July 1, 2006, through June 30, 2007, the Historic District Commission conducted ten (10) public hearings where fourteen (12) applications for Certificates of Appropriateness were reviewed and approved.

The Commission continues to publish its agenda, meeting minutes, historic district regulations, as well as other related matters on the town-wide web site. Additional materials can be obtained at the Planning Board office.

The Commission would like to commend the District's residents for the impeccable designs brought forward in the past year. Significant additions were reviewed and approved at 7 Cottage Street and 38 Cottage Street, while 39 Cottage Street continues to be reviewed.
