Question 1

Shall the Town of Wellesley be allowed to assess an additional \$1,800,000 in real estate and personal property taxes for each of the fiscal years in the period beginning July 1, 2007 and ending June 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding said Town's Group Insurance Liability Fund?

The second ballot question was:

Question 2

Shall the Town of Wellesley be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to fund work associated with the protection and preservation of Morses Pond; stormwater drainage improvements; and school building roof maintenance and replacement, plumbing, heating and electrical system repairs, flooring replacement and ceiling and window replacement?
