forthwith canvassed the same and announced the final results at 8:45 P.M.

The total number of votes cast was as follows:

The ballot question was:

Shall the Town of Wellesley be allowed to exempt from the provisions of Proposition two and one-half, so called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds issued in order to fund the design, construction, equipping and furnishing of a new Wellesley High School at 50 Rice Street, including the cost of acquiring three properties on Seaver Street?
