Petition of F. Diehl & Son, Inc.

Pursuant to due notice the Board of Appeal held a public hearing in the hearing room on the second floor of the Town Hall at 8:30 p.m. on March 21, 1968, on the petition of F. Diehl & Son, Inc., requesting a special permit under the provisions of Section XXIIIA, Part C, Subpart 3 and 7, and Part E, of the Zoning By-law which will allow the applicant to replace three standing signs at 180 Linden Street.

On March 5, 1968, the petitioner requested a hearing before this Board and thereafter due notice was given by mailing and publication.

Joseph M. Kelly, attorney, represented the petitioner at the hearing.

Statement of Facts

The petitioner seeks permission to replace three existing signs which are directional signs for traffic. The signs will be approximately 4' x 4' support by posts and will be 9'9" from the ground to the top. Each sign will be within the existing planters which are 3' x 30". Two of the signs will have the wording, "Entrance - Welcome to Diehl's," and one will have the wording, "Exit and Thank you." All will have white backgrounds with black letters.

A plot plan was submitted drawn by Gleason Engineering Company, which showed the location of the three signs, with one approximately on the street line and two approximately five feet back from the street line.

Decision

The Board finds that the proposed signs which are to replace three existing signs, will be in harmony with the general purpose and intent of Section XXIIIA of the Zoning By-law and will not be injurious to the neighborhood nor to traffic and safety conditions, nor otherwise detrimental to the public safety and welfare.

Accordingly, the Board hereby grants permission for the proposed three signs to be erected as shown on the plan submitted and on file with this Board, within the existing planters.
