



BOARD OF APPEAL

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Petition of Jane Peele Greene

Pursuant to due notice the Board of Appeal held a public hearing in the hearing room on the second floor of the Town Hall at 8:50 p.m. on February 17, 1977, on the petition of Jane Peele Greene, requesting permission to continue to use the premises located at 37 Pond Road, owned by her, as a residence for not more than two families. Said request was made under the provisions of Section II, 8 (a) and Section E 1, of the Zoning By-law.

On January 19, 1977, the petitioner requested a hearing before this Board and thereafter due notice of the hearing was given by mailing and publication.

The petitioner spoke in support of the request at the hearing.

A letter favoring the request was received from Mary H. Pyffe, 99 Pond Road, sister of the petitioner.

Statement of Facts

The house involved is located within a Single Residence District requiring a minimum lot area of 40,000 square feet.

The petitioner seeks permission to continue for another year the present non-conforming use of the above-mentioned property for which a permit was granted by this Board a year ago.

It was stated that the situation is the same as a year ago and the facts are the same as stated in the original application on file, dated March 6, 1973. The petitioner's daughter and another tenant occupy the dwelling. The house is located on approximately ten acres of land and should not prove detrimental to surrounding properties.

Decision

It is the opinion of this Board that the continued use of the dwelling involved as a two-family dwelling, will not substantially reduce the value of any property within the district and will not otherwise injure the neighborhood. It is the further opinion of the Board that there is still a real need for the continuance of the non-conforming use for another year.

Accordingly, a temporary permit is granted under the provisions of Section XXIV-E of the Zoning By-law for one year from the date of this permit, subject to the following condition: That said dwelling shall not be occupied by more than two families at any time.
