**September 4: McFarland, USA (2015)** Track coach Jim White's search for work leads him to a high school in California's Central Valley with a largely Latino student body. After White and his determined athletes establish a bond of trust, remarkable achievements are on the horizon. Rated PG, 129 minutes.

**September 11: The 11th of September: Moyers in Conversation (2001)** Award-winning news journalist Bill Moyers began work on this landmark special just three days after the horrific September 11th, 2001, attacks on America. A sensitive combination of talks with experts, photo montages, poetry and art, this program focuses on the political, social and personal significance of the terror and features the opinions of luminaries such as Broadway director Julie Taymor and Harvard religion professor Diana Eck

**September 18: The Cobbler (2015)** New York shoe repairman Max Simkin has become weary of his drab existence when he discovers that an old stitching machine in his shop has magical properties, enabling Max to fully inhabit the lives of his customers simply by trying on their shoes. **September 25: Black or White (2014)** Still reeling from his wife's death, Elliot Anderson struggles to maintain custody of his biracial granddaughter when her grandmother begins pushing to have the girl sent back to her father -- a crack addict Elliot blames for his daughter's demise. Rated: PG-13, 121 minutes
