

CPC Meeting Minutes –April 2, 2012

The Wellesley Community Preservation Committee met at 6:45 PM in Room 311 at the Wellesley Middle School.

Present were the following CPC members: Tony Parker (Chair), Allan Port (Vice Chair), Dwight Lueth, Jim Conlin, Joan Gaughan, and Barbara McMahon. Absent was Bob Goldkamp. Susan Minio, CPC administrative assistant, was also present.

St. James

Don McCauley, Board of Selectmen, spoke about the St. James property and presented the current cost of the land. CPC has previously voted in support of providing up to \$3.6 million to cover approximately 70% of the land acquisition and to support the land preparation and playing fields.
