This memorandum summarizes the analysis of project-related impacts on the Town of Wellesley Refuse Disposal System.

SOLID WASTE

Solid waste generated at the First Year Residence Hall will be removed from the property by private haulers as is currently standard throughout the Babson College campus. Solid waste will be delivered to trash rooms throughout the building by students. It will then be collected by the custodial staff and stored at a central, internal trash room located near the loading dock. The custodians will move these bins outside the building at the loading dock where it will be picked up daily by a separate crew and taken to the compactors at the College facilities building.

RECYCLABLES

Recyclables generated at the First Year Residence Hall will be removed from the property by private haulers as is currently standard throughout the Babson College campus. Recyclables will be delivered to recycling rooms dispersed throughout the building by students. They will then be collected by the custodial staff and stored at a central, internal recycling room located near the loading dock. The custodians will move these bins outside the building at the loading dock where it will be picked up by a separate crew. Cans, bottles, paper, newspaper, paper board and other hard recyclable plastic will be consolidated into one bin (single stream). Recyclables will be picked up 2-3 times a week depending on volume.

SUMMARY

Refuse disposal & recycling systems are consistent with current Babson standards and will have no negative impact on the Town's refuse disposal system.

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
