Photovoltaic ("PV") Rebate Terms And Conditions

This document describes the Wellesley Municipal Light Plant's ("WMLP") PV rebate requirements. In addition to the Photovoltaic Rebate Terms And Conditions the customer shall comply with the process and requirements outlined in the WMLP's Policy on Interconnection with Distributed Generation. Photovoltaic rebates apply to Interconnection Applications/Interconnection Service Agreements submitted on or after September 1, 2014. Solar installations must be completed by June 30, 2015 to be eligible for rebate.

1. The PV system to be installed:
 - a. Is designed to offset all or part of the customer's annual electrical needs.
 - b. Is located on the customer's premise and within Wellesley Municipal Light Plant's service territory.
 - c. Is a customer owned PV system that is not leased or rented.
2. Customer understands Wellesley Municipal Light Plant does not warranty or in any way guarantee the quality of the PV equipment. Acceptance of such is the customer's responsibility.
3. The customer shall comply with all Town of Wellesley ordinance(s) and obtain all required Town of Wellesley permits.
4. The customer shall complete and submit the required Wellesley Municipal Light Plant Interconnection Service Agreement.
5. Wellesley Municipal Light Plant is NOT party to the installation contract between the customer and contractor/vendor.
6. The customer agrees to grant Wellesley Municipal Light Plant access to the customer's property for the purpose of on-site inspection(s) to verify the site and installed equipment are eligible for rebate.
7. Customer understands Wellesley Municipal Light Plant is not responsible for any Tax Liability associated with the receipt of the Wellesley Municipal Light Plant solar rebate.
8. PV system equipment must carry a minimum of a 5-year warranty on inverters and a 20-year warranty on modules with an overall average output of a minimum of 85% output of manufacturer's designed ratings.
9. A signed copy of this form must be submitted to the Wellesley Municipal Light Plant before December 31, 2014 along with a completed Solar Rebate Application.
10. In order to qualify for the rebate the meter must be installed and Witness Test completed on, or before, June 30, 2015.
11. The rebate will be in the form of a check from the Town of Wellesley or a credit to your electric account, at the sole discretion of Wellesley Municipal Light Plant.

I certify that I have read and understand the Photovoltaic Rebate Terms And Conditions and will procure all necessary building permits required for the PV system installation and comply with the WMLP's Policy on Interconnection with Distributed Generation.
