Petition of F. Diehl & Son, Inc.

Pursuant to due notice the Board of Appeal held a public hearing in the hearing room on the second floor of the Town Hall at 8:00 p.m. on May 25, 1967, on the petition of F. Diehl & Son, Inc., requesting a special permit under the provisions of Section XXIIIA, Part E, of the Zoning By-law which will allow the erection of a wall sign on the side of the building at 185-189 Linden Street. Said sign would be in violation of Section XXIIIA, Subpart 3. a. 3 (a) of the Zoning By-law which prohibits the erection of more than one exterior sign for each business establishment consisting of a single building except that if such building has more than one public entrance.

On March 27, 1967, the petitioner requested a hearing before this Board and thereafter due notice was given by mailing and publication.

Joseph M. Kelly, attorney, represented the petitioner at the hearing.

John D. Murphy, Vice president of F. Diehl & Son, Inc., spoke in favor of granting the request.

Statement of Facts

The petitioner seeks permission to erect a sign over the Drive-in teller window on the side of the South Shore National Bank building. Said sign is designed to be four feet wide and two feet high, with the wording, "Auto Bank" in black letters on a white background. While the bank has a sign on the front of the building, it is felt by the petitioner that it is also necessary to identify the location of the drive-in window for those approaching by car.

Decision

The Board of Appeal finds that the proposed sign will be in harmony with the general purpose and intent of Section XXIIIA of the Zoning By-law and will not be injurious to the neighborhood nor to traffic and safety conditions, nor otherwise detrimental to the public safety and welfare.

Accordingly, the Board hereby grants permission for the proposed sign to be erected on the side of the building in accordance with the application submitted and on file with this Board.
