Petition of Wellesley Inn, Inc.

Pursuant to due notice the Board of Appeal held a public hearing in the hearing room on the second floor of the Town Hall at 8:20 p.m. on June 22, 1967, on the petition of Wellesley Inn, Inc., requesting a special permit under the provisions of Section XXIIIA, Part B of the Zoning By-law which will allow the applicant to erect an "AAA" sign on the building at 576 Washington Street.

On May 19, 1967, the petitioner requested a hearing before this Board and thereafter due notice of the hearing was given by mailing and publication.

William W. White, Assistant Treasurer of Wellesley Inn, Inc., spoke in support of the petition at the hearing.

Statement of Facts

The petitioner seeks permission to erect a standard "AAA Approved" emblem which will indicate its membership in the AAA Association. It is to be hung on a metal bracket which will extend out from the building approximately thirty inches. The emblem itself will be 30" wide and 23" high, and will have the wording, "AAA Approved" in black and white.

A photograph of the proposed sign and bracket was submitted at the hearing. The petitioner feels there is a need for the proposed sign as it is the only way to display its membership in the AAA Association.

Decision

The Board finds that the proposed sign will be in harmony with the general purpose and intent of Section XXIIIA of the Zoning By-law and will not be injurious to the neighborhood nor to traffic and safety conditions, nor otherwise detrimental to the public safety and welfare.

Accordingly, the Board hereby grants permission for the proposed sign to be erected as shown on the plan submitted and on file with this Board.
