

WHAT IS THE ELDERLY AND DISABLED TAXATION FUND?

The Town of Wellesley accepted the provisions of Massachusetts General 60 Section 3D at the 2003 Annual Town Meeting.

The Fund was established to accept donations from taxpayers that will then be used to offset an elderly or disabled individuals tax obligation.

WHAT ARE THE RULES AND REGULATIONS?

A Taxation Fund Committee comprised of the chair of the Board of Assessors, Town Treasurer and 3 individuals appointed by the Board of Selectmen, will establish the rules and regulations.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Procedures need to be established by the Taxation Fund Committee.

WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

Qualifications are yet to be established by the Taxation Fund Committee.

HOW DO I DONATE?

Donations to the fund can be made in any amount over \$1.00 to the **Taxation Aid Fund** and mailed to:
