

**Board of Selectmen Meeting: November 13, 2013**

Meeting called to order at 5:30 PM in the Juliani Room

Ms. Babson reported the Board's decision to call a special town meeting within the December 9, 2013 special town meeting to seek additional planning funds for the Tolles-Parsons Center project.

**The Board voted (5-0) to open the Warrant for the special town meeting within the December 9, 2013 special town meeting and to close and sign the Warrant on Tuesday, November 19, 2013 at 5:00 pm.**

Ms. Freiman, Chair of the Advisory Committee, noted the upcoming meeting schedules for the Advisory Committee and determined the public hearing for the newly called special town meeting would be on Wednesday, November 20, 2013.

Ms. Babson noted the Selectmen were presenting their Capital Budget to the Advisory Committee later in the evening and asked Ms. Freiman if she could inform the public of the decision to not file an appeal and to call a special town meeting at the Advisory Committee meeting because it was televised. Ms. Freiman agreed.
