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CHAPTER VI

RUBBISH HAULERS

- 1.00 Pursuant to Massachusetts General Law Chapter III, Section 31B, all persons collecting trash in the Town of Wellesley shall obtain a permit from the Board of Health.

Trash hauling permits shall be valid for one calendar year, renewable annually on the first day of January subject to review and approval by the Board of Health. No permit shall be transferable except with the approval of the Board of Health. Any application which fails to include all information requested in the Board of Health regulations shall be deemed incomplete and shall be denied.

As part of the application, each applicant shall submit to the Board of Health a list of customers served, time of day and frequency of collection, tons of solid waste and recyclables handled on a regular basis.

- 2.00 Each permittee shall provide trash and recycling services in compliance with the State of Massachusetts Solid Waste Plan and DEP regulations. Each permittee shall submit monthly reports listing the tonnage of refuse and recyclables that has been collected. Said report shall include a list of customers served, time of day and frequency of collection and a process for resolving residential complaints or permit violations. All permitted haulers are required to provide weight slips or vendor receipts to document tons of recyclables collected and trash collected. Said report shall be submitted to the Department of Public Works, Recycling and Disposal Facility, beginning one month from the application approval date and continuing each month during which the applicant holds a valid permit. Failure to provide this required information may result in revocation, modification, or suspension of the permit.
- 3.00 Any member of the Board of Health or its agents, or other persons designated by the Board of Health may enforce this section. Any violation of this regulation, the Department of Environmental Protection regulations, or the Massachusetts General Laws by the permitted hauler shall be grounds for suspension, modification, or revocation of the permit.
- 4.00 An application fee, per truck shall be submitted with all applications.
