

COVID-19 BOOSTER INFORMATION

Who is eligible to get a booster?

1 People who are immunocompromised

Individuals who are immunocompromised due to particular health conditions have been eligible for a booster dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine since August 13.

2 People who received the Pfizer vaccine

3 People who received the Moderna vaccine

You are now eligible for a booster dose 6 months after your second shot if you are:

- Age 65+
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who live or work in a high-risk settings

Mixing vaccines: If you received your second Pfizer OR Moderna shot at least 6 months ago and you meet the eligibility criteria, you can get Moderna, Pfizer or J&J now.

4 People who received the J&J vaccine

You are now eligible for a booster dose 2 months after your initial dose of the J&J vaccine if you are 18 years old or older.

Mixing vaccines: If you got a J&J shot at least 2 months ago, you can get Moderna, Pfizer or J&J now.
