

## ***Quercus palustris* – Pin Oak**



**Foliage: Glossy dark green in summer, russet or bronze in fall**

**Habit: In youth often pyramidal becoming rounded**

**Bark: Grayish brown and smooth in youth, ridged as matures**

**Flowers: Yellowish green pendulous catkins in spring**

**Fruit: Small acorn**

**Very few insect and disease issues**

**Size: 50+ feet**

**Culture: Full sun and tolerates wet soils**

**Landscape Value: Lovely specimen tree for lawn, park or street with interesting form.**

**Native to New England**
