

## ***Quercus palustris* – Pin Oak**



**Foliage:** Glossy dark green in summer, russet or bronze in fall

**Habit:** In youth often pyramidal becoming rounded

**Bark:** Grayish brown and smooth in youth, ridged as matures

**Flowers:** Yellowish green pendulous catkins in spring

**Fruit:** Small acorn

**Very few insect and disease issues**

**Size:** 50+ feet

**Culture:** Full sun and tolerates wet soils

**Landscape Value:** Lovely specimen tree for lawn, park or street with interesting form.

**Native to New England**
