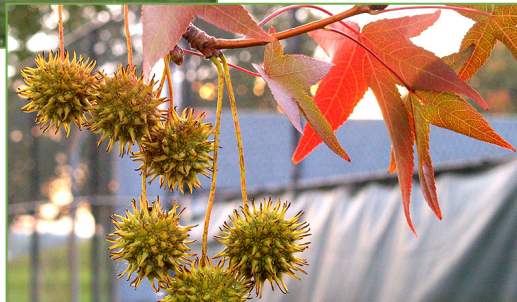


## ***Liquidambar styraciflua* – Sweetgum**



**Foliage:** Shiny green in summer, red, orange, yellow in fall

**Bark:** Grayish brown with corky ridges

**Fruit:** Fruit is kind of frightening but fun (see photo)

**Form:** Pyramidal when young, rounded at maturity

**No insect or disease issues**

**Size:** 40 – 50 feet

**Culture:** Full sun

**Landscape Value:** Beautiful lawn, park or shade tree that  
needs plenty of room to develop roots

**Native to New England and Central Coast**
