

RECYCLABLE OF THE MONTH:

Oct. 2024

Leaves + Grass
Brush + Wood



ITEMS: keep the 2 separate: **Leaves + Grass / Brush + Wood**

Leaves & Grass may include brown paper lawn leaf bags!

Brush & Wood = cuttings from shrubs, bushes, trees & Natural wood only. Don't exceed 3" in diameter nor 4' in length. No construction debris. No wooden fencing.

HOW TO RECYCLE: go to YARD WASTE / COMPOSTING Area

Discard Leaves + Grass to left of sign over the Jersey barrier wall.

Discard Brush + Wood to the right of sign - in large pile.

RECYCLING FACTS:

- **First, try to Grass-cycle:** when you mow, leave grass clippings on the lawn to (1) improve lawn quality since they decay naturally, (2) release valuable nutrients, (3) add water-saving mulch, encouraging natural soil aeration by earthworms!! & (4) reduce the need for chemical fertilizers!
- **Wood** is 1 of the most valuable recyclable materials: it can be made into a wide variety of products: mulch, wood pellets, compost additive, soil conditioner, animal bedding and feedstock for engineered woods.
- **1 TREE** absorbs ~250 lbs. of carbon dioxide each year! Carbon dioxide, a greenhouse gas, is a major contributor to global warming. The more trees left standing, the healthier is our planet's atmosphere!
