## WESTON ROAD RECONSTRUCTION

Following the recent road detour for utility and tree work, the project will continue with curbing, sidewalk, and ADA installations with only shoulder or single-lane impacts this fall. Road detours will occur Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 8:30am-2:30pm, with possible one-lane closures at other times during 7am-5pm work hours. Expect traffic delays and consider alternate routes during construction. Work is expected to continue up until winter time and then the final work and paving will take place in the spring.



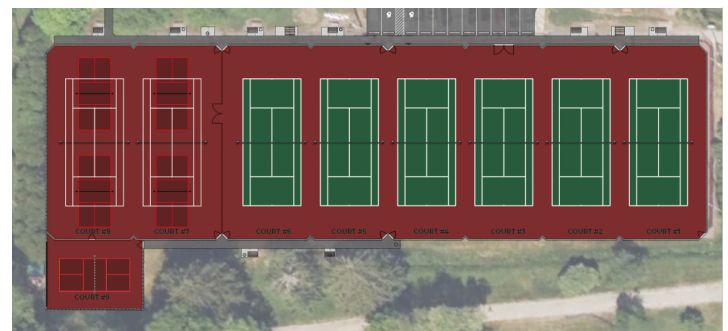

## HUNNEWELL SPORTS COURTS

The interior construction is underway and progressing well. The foundational work has been completed with all 88 fence posts installed, the perimeter concrete curb finished, and the asphalt binder placed.

Infrastructure improvements are also planned, including replacing the electrical cabinet at the rear side of the courts and installing a new water line to the water station. The project remains on track for completion in late September or early October.

## ROAD RESURFACING

Wellesley roadway resurfacing will occur September 5th through 12th during overnight hours (8:00 PM to 5:00 AM) to avoid disrupting school buses and daily commutes. Residents must move parked vehicles from streets during work hours and turn off sprinkler systems. Property owners should trim overhanging vegetation back to property lines and clearly mark invisible fences or low-voltage systems near pavement. The work will produce minimal noise and may extend slightly beyond pavement edges. Avoid sharp vehicle turns for 24 hours after completion.

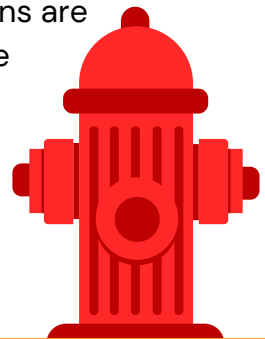
## HYDRANT FLUSHING

We will be conducting hydrant flushing from October 20<sup>th</sup> through October 24<sup>th</sup> as part of our routine water system maintenance. During this time, you may experience temporary water discoloration that appears cloudy, yellow, or brown, as well as reduced water pressure. These conditions are normal and typically resolve within 2-4 hours after flushing is completed in your area. We appreciate your patience as we work to maintain the quality and reliability of our water system.

- Linden Street / Between #277 – #279

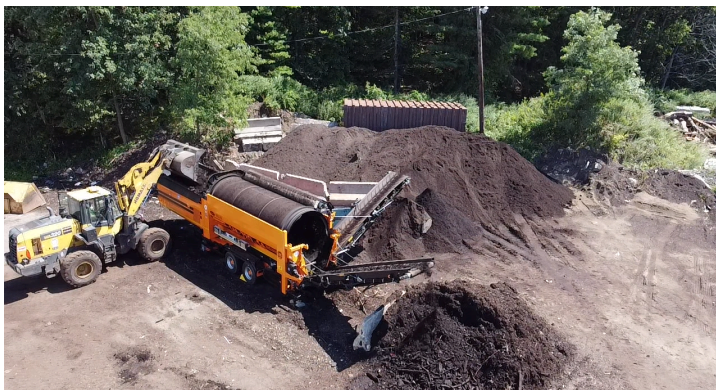

The RDF purchased a new screener this summer to improve processing efficiency of leaves and compost materials that residents and contractors drop off at the site disposal area. The RDF processes thousands of yards of green waste annually, and the screener separates fully composted material from material that returns to composting windrows for further processing.
